These are qualities that we are trying to build up in ourselves and in others.

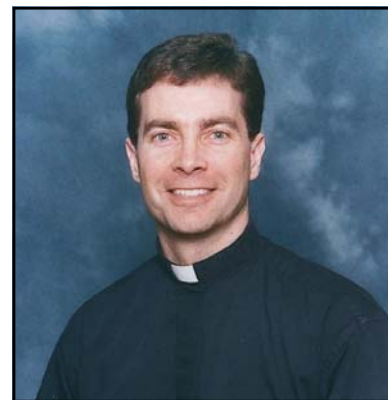
