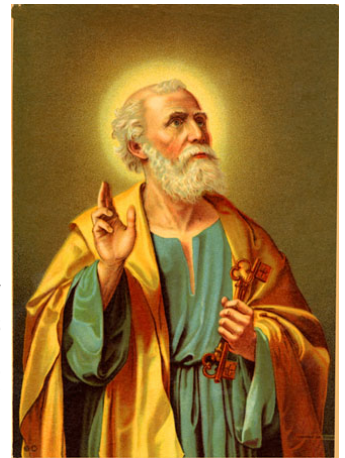
1. God loves all of the people in the whole world and wants everyone to be saved.
